MEDICAL VISA

To apply for <u>eVisa</u>: apply online at the following link: <u>www.indianvisaonline.gov.in/evisa</u> It is processed only online, it is not required to come to the Embassy. The Embassy does not have interference on it as it is processed in India.

To apply for a <u>Regular Paper Visa</u>, fill in online form at the following link: <u>www.indianvisaonline.gov.in/visa</u>. Visit the Embassy along with the documents mentioned below:

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

- 1. **Print out of the Visa Application Form** which must include the <u>uploaded photograph</u> (white background and front) completed with all the required data. The application must be <u>signed</u> in the box below the photograph on Page 1 and at the end of Page 2. The signatures must be the same as those in your passport.
- 2. **Two 5x5cm photographs:** white background and front. <u>One must be pasted in the box indicated on Page 1</u>. And the second photo must be delivered to the Consular Services Assistant.
- 3. **Original passport** valid for a minimum of 6 months from the expiration date of the visa and at least two free pages.
- 4. A signed photocopy of the passport page containing the applicant's details.
- 5. A signed photocopy of the International Yellow Fever Vaccination Certificate. Please note that even if you have a valid Indian visa, the Indian immigration and health authorities may deny your entry to the country if you do not carry the Yellow Fever Vaccination Certificate.
- 6. **Bank statements** with sufficient balance to cover for the cost of treatment and expenditures during the period of stay in India.
- 7. For Medical/ Ayush Visa applicants needs to have a valid Medical Appointment Letter from genuine hospitals by pre-validating Medical Visa. Applicants are advised to visit the 'Medical and Ayush Visa Portal' by usina **URL** https://indianfrro.gov.in/frro/medicalvaluetravel to generate Medical Visa Invitation letter and Medical Visa Extension Letter for Medical Visa/Medical Attendant Visa/Ayush Visa/Ayush Attendant Visa which needs to be submitted with the Visa application form.

This portal enables hospitals, on-board the portal 'Medical and Ayush Visa Portal', to generate Medical Visa invitation Letter and Medical Visa Extension Letter for Medical Visa/Medical Attendant Visa/Ayush Attendant Visa.

The pre-validation of Medical Visa is pre requisite to acquire Medical Visa and Medical Visa will be issued only after pre-validation letter generated from the portal.

IMPORTANT NOTE The consular officer may request additional documentation as considered at the time of the interview. Expat applicants may apply for a business visa only if they have lived in Argentina or Uruguay for at least two years. **Incomplete applications will not be accepted.** For information on rates, please refer to the Fee Structure.
